Half bushel shares cost \$590 each and full bushel shares cost \$850 each. Egg shares are 1 dozen cage free eggs per week for the season and cost \$90 each.

The 2021 CSA program will run for at least 16-18 weeks and will be split into three seasons: Spring distributions will begin in mid May and will run for 4-6 weeks Summer distributions will begin in early July and will run for 6, or so, weeks Fall distributions will begin in mid September and will run for 6, or so, weeks. (in 2018 our season ran 19 weeks, in 2019 we ran 20 weeks, and in 2020 we ran for 20 weeks)

Half bushel shares work well for individuals, couples, and families with one or two small children. Full bushel shares are better suited to larger families or can be shared between two smaller families.

For the spring season shares are likely to include peas, strawberries, lettuce, greens, beets, summer squash, spring onions, lettuce, cherries, broccoli, cabbage, and cauliflower.

For the summer season we plan to have green beans, sweet corn, tomatoes, melons, peppers, summer squash, peaches, cucumbers, plums, onions, potatoes, eggplant, blueberries, okra, and blackberries.

For the fall season we typically have green beans, sweet potatoes, apples, celery, raspberries, broccoli, pears, greens, cauliflower, cabbage, turnips, pumpkins, and winter squash.

If you are on vacation, and unable to pick up your share, please make arrangements for a friend to pick it up instead. There are no refunds for shares not picked up. If shares are not picked up within 24 hours the produce will be donated to charity.

We employ many risk management techniques on our farm including irrigation and deer fencing to reduce the chance of crop loss. We will do our best and expect to provide you with the variety and quantities of produce advertised. However there remains some risk of potential crop loss. In the event of such loss, the quantity or variety of produce in your share may be different than what is advertised.
